I would like to thank the GSR once again. for the trust by electing me alternate RCM. As I am getting ready to continue my services as representant of the area to the region, I had some reflections about the year and realized how important it is for the area to have our voice heard at the region and simultaneously how important it is to have a year of apprenticeship as a preparation to adequately perform the duties of RCM. I will strive to always be part of the solutions and not the problems and function to the best of my abilities.

I attended the **Off Month Regional Meeting on November 9, 2019.** There were 7 areas represented out of 10

The following topics were discussed:

- 1) The Conference Agenda Report (CAR reports) will be posted on www.na.org.conference
 Hard copies are being issued by the Word Services (NAWS) at the cost \$13.50 + tax. The scheduled release date was November 26. You are also welcome to download the report free of charge at the world on the website listed above.
- 2) The Regional Delegate (RD) and Regional Delegate Alternate will be conducting workshops for the CAR, on a first come first serve basis. We will get specific info on dates and locations for those who are interested, GSR, please inform your home groups members about the report.
- Below is a listing of select activities going on at the NAWS:
 - a. IP project on Mental Health is progressing. The approval draft will be on the 2020 Conference Agenda Report for fellowship wide review. Please visit www.na.prg/mhmi. For more information
 - b. The book project "Spiritual Principle a Day..." (SPAD) is also progressing. The first review and input deadline was September 1. If you want more info on the current materials for the book go to www.na.org/spad

- c. Tool box project: GSR basics is available for review. If you would like to participate in this project, the web address is: toolbox@na.org
- d. The next world convention will be at Melbourne Australia. The dates selected are 9-12 September 2021 (these are tentative dates subjects to some changes). Begin to plan if you are planning to attend.
- 4) A motion to allocate \$2000 for the Susquehanna area to have a billboard in order to reach a large number of people was passed by acclamation. The actual cost from Clear channel is \$1900 and a check has been issued for that amount. The goal is to rotate the billboards in all areas. As an indicator of the impact of the billboard, in the Baltimore area during time the billboard was here, there was an increase of the calls to the phone line.
- 5) Next month I will give more details about the current Zonal discussion and Zoom report. Just off hand, the Region has decided by consensus not to create a new position of treasurer at the Zone.
- 6) Open Positions:
