Hello everyone,

Please review the updated information as I will not be able to attend the September Area Service Meeting.

I attended the Regional meeting here at the service center on August 11,2018. The other Hotline Chairpersons in attendance where: Baltimore, Ocean Gateway, Susquehanna and Westside. We discussed ways to try and recruit volunteers for the Hotline and become a volunteer for the 12 Step Caller List. I also have the requirements to become a 12 Step Volunteer. Please contact me for more information. The volunteer would be given the hotline caller's name and telephone number and not the other way around. Your information is confidential and is not shared with any person outside of the phone line committee.

The Hotline Sub-Committee meeting was held here at the Service Center on Saturday, August 25, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. Myself and another volunteer was in attendance. I provided training from the Hotline Training Manual for the volunteer and he has now completed the required training to answer calls from the hotline.

I have not as of yet (August 28, 2018) received any new information for the chart below from the Regional Hotline Chairperson. I tried to reach out to the Regional Hotline Chair to receive the new information but have not heard from him.

**Our sub-committee also needs a Vice Chair and a Secretary. The clean time requirement for the Vice Chair is 2 years and the Secretary requirement is 1 year. For both positions the individual must have knowledge of the 12 steps, 12 traditions and the 12 Concepts of NA. (Per Training Booklet).**
