RCM Report

Greetings to all

Happy New Year!!!

I attended the **On Month Regional Meeting on December 14, 2019**. There were 9 areas represented out of 10

The following topics were discussed:

- 1) The Regional Delegate presented a report of the MRLE-CAR Workshop they attended at New Hampshire last month. Inside the CAR Report there is a Tally Sheet. The purpose of the Tally Sheet is to collect responses from the fellowship on the Motions and Surveys included in the CAR Report. Every home group is strongly encouraged to fill the tally in order to have our voices heard. The deadline to bring the sheets will be at our area meeting on Saturday, March 7. Alternatively, members can fill this survey online at www.na.org/survey until April 1, 2020. If the area allows it, I will schedule a workshop on the report with the RDs on February. The workshop will be open to any interested members.
- 2) The Alternate Regional Delegate also discussed the CAR Workshop. The following workshops were stressed out: Goals of WSC, Role of Zones, Zonal Collaboration, Effective and Sustainable WSC. He also discussed about the Issue Discussion Topics (IDT): The Attracting Members to Service IDT, Carrying the Message and Making NA Attractive IDT, and finally the Drug Replacement Therapy/Medication Assisted Treatment IDT.

A motion that will be presented is to pool the money for zonal meetings and divide by 5 instead of each region assuming the cost individually when they host.

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3) The FRSCNA presented a report of the Regional Convention. The convention was a success. It was well attended: 800 registrations were sold and 200 Newcomer packages given. All funds raising activities, banquet, luncheon, merchandise, raffle... did generate a lot of funds. A check of \$11,000 was given to the Region as reimbursement for the monies which were previously given to the committee. In addition, they were able to replenish \$15,000 to the prudent reserve and set aside \$10,000 startup money the 2021 convention. The ad hoc Fundraising committee was of great help, bringing in \$13,816.00. The convention will be held every other year.

4) The Website administrator reported a record of 9700 visits in September, going down to an average of 5000-7000 in October and November.

They made some changes to the Website: Finalized Regional Meeting Schedule, using BMLT website plugin, and created a HOW-to page, that explains how to print the Regional Schedule for distribution.

Added the latest version of Together We can, and took down the FreeState Convention slider. There is a need for Event Coordinator to add pages whenever there is an event. A sample of future changes will include: adding area meeting schedules link for up-to-date area tri-fold meeting schedules; finalize online meeting schedule change for the public, add CAR report link page.

5) Sub-committee reports: H&I discussed issues with the Westside Patuxent facility. They might let that go.

Phoneline sub-committee discussed missed calls and open shift and penalty for missing shift works. 101/107 shift are currently filled.

Literature second batch of literature review due 03/01/2020.

Public Relations Billboard in Susquehanna area is up. I asked the question about how they decide about the distribution to all areas. I was explained to me it was random. PR chairs in each area need to help for billboard in their area.

The committee will continue to hold meetings to professional in the region interested for info about NA. An interview with Clear Channel may be scheduled soon.

Special Events presented a list of all event during the holidays in the region, and future events. Fliers are on the table.

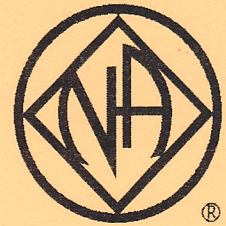
