- 5. For each responsibility assigned to the service structure, a single point of decision and accountability should be clearly defined.**
- 6. Group conscience is the spiritual means by which we invite a loving God to influence our decisions.**
- 7. All members of a service body bear substantial responsibility for that body's decisions and should be allowed to fully participate in its decision-making processes.**
- 8. Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications.**

- 9. All elements of our service structure have the responsibility to carefully consider all viewpoints in their decision-making processes.**
- 10. Any member of a service body can petition that body for the redress of a personal grievance, without fear of reprisal.**
- 11. NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly.**
- 12. In keeping with the spiritual nature of Narootics Anonymous, our structure should always be one of service, never of government.**

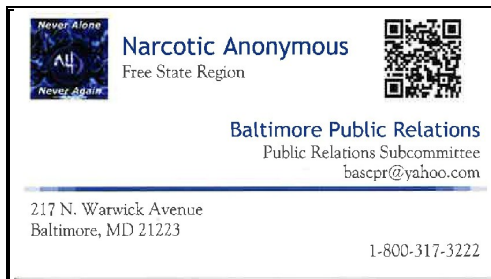

1. Baltimore Pride Event. We shared a tent and table with NEFA on Saturday, June 25th from 12-9 pm at the Charles and 20th block party, making NA literature and schedules available. There were over 300 requests for Baltimore Area schedules.

Greetings to all,

We held our H & I subcommittee on June 25 from 12:45-2:15 pm.

We had a total of 11 people in attendance including 2 new members.

We opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the serenity prayer.

After the NA readings, we discussed old and new business and any concerns.

Open Positions: Vice Chair and Secretary

Open Slots: Bayview; Wednesday from 8-9 pm; week 3 (Panel Leader)-1-year clean
Open Discussion Meeting

Old Business: Discussion regarding new facilities took place which is now new business.

New Business:

- **CMDS-Clinical Management & Development Services** was voted in for meetings. The facility is located at 15 South Fulton Street. This is a women’s treatment facility. I contacted the liaison on June 29th and a confirmation letter will be emailed with the day and time requested. The days requested are Wednesday from 7-8 pm or Sunday from 4-5 pm.
- **Central Booking Intake/Male** facility requested meetings from H&I. The chair person from PR and myself met with the contact. The H&I subcommittee was presented with the request and voted to accept the responsibility. Application packets were emailed for completion by all volunteers. A short video orientation is also required. Male volunteers are needed. A requirement to volunteer is that any felony charges be at least 10+ years old. We also voted William H. in as the coordinator for this facility. Another volunteer is also completing an application along with William and will be returned to the liaison. The women’s facility is on hold until successful meetings for the men are made. We also received another

request for the women's facility in Jessup and this will be discussed at our next subcommittee meeting.

- The **Helping Up Mission** is requesting meetings on Saturday or Sunday. Either 9 or 11 am; 7-5 pm. Our committee discussed this and the panel leaders will visit the facility to view spacing. If all is well, we can service the facility on weekends.
- **Northwest Hospital**-I spoke to the coordinator regarding an update on meetings for this facility. They are ready to start meetings back up and the coordinator suggested we come in twice a month as opposed to twice a week. We will discuss this at our next meeting. The previous meeting was on Tuesday and Thursday from 8-9 pm every week.
- **Gaudenzia**-Due to a Covid-19 notification at the facility, 2 weeks of meeting were cancelled and have been resumed on June 21st. All is well
- **BHS**-The Gaudenzia coordinator received a meeting request from BHS for meetings at their facility. This will be discussed further at our monthly meeting.

Charvette created an order form for the facilities that will be used for replenishing of facility literature. Thanks Charvette! Also, I am in the process of updating our H&I prologue for the various types of facilities post pandemic. A short orientation packet will also be put together for new members and coordinators so coordinators can share with panel leaders-panel leaders with speakers etc. Mostly dos and don'ts basics. An H&I Volunteer Sign-Up Sheet will be presented to the GSR's to take back to their homegroup. If anyone is interested in becoming a volunteer, they can contact the H&I Chairperson.

WE ARE IN NEED OF VOLUNTEERS!!!!

Requests for H&I services are increasing across the city, unfortunately we are unable to service them all and a waitlist is kept through Public Relations. 4. The Baltimore Area of NA no longer has events that have no donation fee and free food, and drinks are given away. (09/03/05) (pertain to all subcommittees?)
7. Any meeting that meets at a facility that requires the use of electronic media or requires ID to enter that facility to access an NA meeting be stricken from the Regional Schedule. (12/01/07) (revisit for clarity/does it pertain to home groups-Outdated?)
9. Whenever the Baltimore Area Special Events rents or subleases the kitchen, there should (shall/will) be a 3 or more bidding process. If there are not 3 bids, there should (shall/will) be a plausible explanation given. (2013/01/05) (for clarity) no vote needed
10. No checks should (shall/will) be dispersed without producing a receipt for the previous month's expenses. (2013/06/01) Amendment to Article 15 #5. (for clarity) no vote needed
