March was an awful month for the phone line. I can't sugar coat that shit, it's been a while since I've seen missed call volume this high. Specifically my hometown NEFA area dropping big balls and calls this month *see attached*

The numbers:

Total calls: 148 (up about 30-40 from previous months)

Total incoming calls: 122
Total missed calls: 32! (WTF)

VM: 5

Missed after VM: 27

% missed: 22%

It's piss poor really and sad that we have over 100 volunteers that can't manage 140

calls. I understand why a lot would vote against an automated system but these are the reasons why. Especially if someone is just looking for a meeting, there aren't 32 of those requests going unanswered every month with a digital system. And for those looking to speak with someone, we have a dedicated person for that shift. With numbers like these, it's hard to argue against the change....

The breakdown.....

- -26 of the 32 missed calls were "user hung up". This means a call came in and the volunteer likely hit the "eff u" button. That shuts the whole call down, it will NOT continue onto the next person in the chain. DOA if that happens. Next month, if the numbers look like this, I'm gonna remove every first tier person that did it so please reach out to your people and let them know not to do it. Highlighted in the doc are the numbers of those guilty. With a little bit of training, we could likely have a way better month next month
- -8 of the above cases were on Thursday 7:30am-1pm and 1pm-5pm. I spoke to Mike and Tom and there were some mix ups and discrepancies with the system on those shifts that could have accounted for a few of the missed calls.
- -Thursday 5pm-8pm were this month's rock-stars. They had 11 calls the month of march and didn't miss one as a team. That's amazing. There were other shifts too that did very well but they were the top and deserve some pandering in my monthly email.

Open Shifts:

Tuesday 5pm-8pm – needs 1 Thursday 1pm-5pm – needs 1 Thursday 7:30am-1pm – needs 1

Again, I can't stress this enough, let your people know that if they can't answer a call for any reason either; 1. may be on the wrong shift for them, or

2. PLEASE FOR THE LOVE OF GOD, let it ring all the way through so the call has a chance. Or if they pick up, don't hang up!

Lastly is the total phoneline volume report and area chair report. Let me know if any corrections are needed.
