AD.*

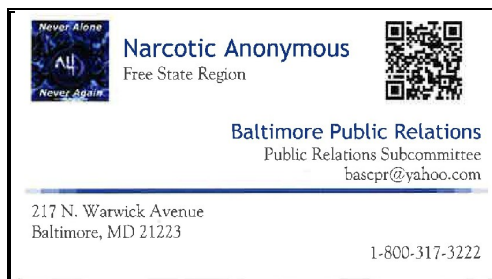
*The first order of business was the Freestate Convention Committees report;

❖ Information about NA:

Narcotics Anonymous is a global, community-based organization with a multi-lingual and multicultural membership. NA was founded in 1953, and our membership growth was minimal during our initial twenty years as an organization. Since the publication of our Basic Text in 1983, the number of members and meetings has increased dramatically. Today, NA members hold nearly 76,000 meetings weekly in 143 countries. We offer recovery from the effects of addiction through working a twelve-step program, including regular attendance at group meetings.

- I. The February 2023 Public Relations Subcommittee meeting was held on Monday, Feb. 27. This was a virtual meeting. The meeting opened and closed with the “We” version of the Serenity Prayer. Regular Subcommittee meetings are held on the 4th Monday of each month on Zoom at 6 pm.

b. NA Tradition Issues:

- We were contacted several times in January and February by a member of the One Promise Group (Tues & Thur. 12 – 1, at St. Barts), complaining that the trusted servants were not following NA traditions – in terms of (1) treatment of members in the meeting, (2) handling of 7th tradition funds, and (3) setting up business meetings. After visiting and observing the group in January, the group secretary/GSR notified PR that it was re-listing the group in the Westside Area. Based on continued calls from a group member, I visited the Westside Area PR subcommittee and informed them of the member's concerns. Most recently, it was reported that the group secretary/GSR had threatened to switch the group from NA to AA. In checking the FSRNA schedule, as of yesterday the meeting is no longer listed in the FSRNA meeting list.

Thank you for your vote of confidence to serve as the H&I Chair. We had our subcommittee meeting virtually on February 25th (see attached agenda).

The literature report was shared from the end of last service year, which included the inventory of leftover items. These items will be physically sorted in preparation for the facilities we currently serve to receive as needed. Literature will also be shared during professional H&I presentations to new facilities during outreach and learning day/workshops. We discussed looking at our current literature request form to address being prudent with spending, addressing the introduction of NA to the potential addict in facilities that we serve and include our literature order form to facilities to begin purchasing literature.

Articles X: Subcommittees —

1. **H& I**—no revisions
