October 2, 2021 RCM Report

Good morning

I attended the hybrid Off-Month Regional meeting on September 11, 2021. Six (6) areas were in attendance.

Unfortunately, the Minutes and Reports from the meeting are not yet posted at the Freestate website, nor did we receive a report via email. A summary of the discussions is presented below.

• 1) Nominations

- a) The first point of discussion was the nomination and subsequent election of the new Secretary Kristie, effective immediately.
- b) A Vice-Treasurer was also elected, Eminda. A motion was made

to waive the clean time requirement for the position in order for her to qualify.

- c) Finally a Vice-Secretary, Shelby was also elected.
- 2) Free State: Wayne-
- a) Three out of four meals are sold out. Arrangements are being made to switch room in order to increase the number of participants.
- b) The Pre-Registration target of 500 is almost achieved. Only a few (less than 80) are left
- 3) **Chair- Kellie:** Absent, but did send a written report. Details to follow.
- 4) **Policy Facilitator- Joe:** No Report
- 5) **RD Report: Chris**:
- a) There are currently four (4) pending motions at the World regarding WSCNA.
- b) There is also a new experiment (a the Zone??) regarding a shift in deliberation process. The body decided to move from the more rigid Robert Rules of Orders to a more flexible Consensus making process. This new system will require at least 80% of votes to move a discussion and adoption of resolutions/motions. Also, permission to speak would be extended to anyone in attendance. The new system will rely heavily on

straw polls; if there is a strong consensus in the straw poll, the resolution will be adopted. More details and clarifications to follow

6) Treasurer: April

- a) Around \$10,000 are available to donate.
- b) There was also an update on the quest for Region-wide Insurance ad hoc committee.
 April did obtain info from areas with current insurance for their groups (SWANA, Susquehanna, and Northwest). The committee is now at the stage of obtaining quotes. The costs and risks will be detailed separately for each area.

• 7) Old Business:

a) The motion submitted by Baltimore regarding cash flow at the zone was put on the

floor for a vote after a few discussions. As a reminder, the amended version reads: "The Baltimore Area of Narcotics Anonymous moves that the Free State Region of Narcotics Anonymous to donate all funds in excess of Prudent Reserve, Budgeted Items and Earmarks, to NAWS. Maker: Baltimore Mario 2nd Michelle H NW". The vote for yes was unanimous, and the motion did pass. As a result, \$10,690.90 should be sent to the World.
