# The final responsibility and authority for NA services rests with the NA groups. (Abridged)

The NA service structure has been created by the groups to serve the needs of the group. Our fellowship's service boards and committees exist to help groups share their experience with one another, provide tools which help groups function better, attract new members to group recovery meetings, and to carry the message further than any single group could carry it alone. Because the groups have created the service structure, they have the final authority over all its affairs. By the same token, the groups also have the final responsibility for the *support* of *all* its activities. The two go hand in hand.
