Everyone please continue to be mindful, stay woke and be safe. **Wash your hands!!**

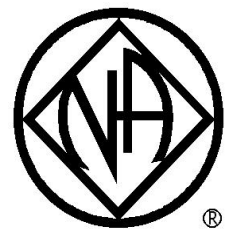
