1. Baltimore Pride Event – (Saturday, June 13, 2026). The non-profit registration fee ranges from \$100 to \$550. Saturday-only, Single Booth Rental is \$478.54. In previous years, Baltimore shared the cost of this event with the Northeast Freedom Area. The total cost for Baltimore Area is \$239.27 for registration, plus insurance and literature. (\$300 was approved as part of PR's 2026 approved budget. ***The application has been submitted, and a reimbursement request has been submitted to the BASC Treasurer.***)
2. Literature Drops: Would like to resume literature drops at MedStar facilities such as Harbor Hospital. [IPs – Introduction; Am I an Addict; H&I – Just For Today]
3. Bus Hut Signage – Discussed resuming the bus hut project, which was last done in 2024 with the Northeast Freedom Area. Four bus hut locations for four weeks is estimated to cost between \$1,500 and \$1,600. In the past the cost was split three ways, between Baltimore, Northeast Freedom and Freestate. (\$577 was approved as part of PR's 2026 approved budget. This year we may partner with either the Greater Annapolis Area or the Susquehanna Area since Northeast Freedom just recently had billboards posted in March. The expenditure will likely occur in August or September.)
