RCM Report

Good morning

The on-month Regional meeting was held on ZOOM August 8, 2020 with 7 Area presents.

The following were discussed during the meeting:

- 1) **Region Chair** started by thanking the region for his time on service the last two years. Vows to remain in service in some capacity at the region
- 2) Vice-chair suggested guidelines for open-meetings. There should be a signing sheet with the name of participants and a contact number in case someone tests positive for COVID 19. Always wear masks and social distancing. Use disinfecting wipes before and after meetings especially door knobs, chairs. Be aware and follow state protocols and guidelines.
- 3) The **PR chair fr**om our area wanted to know if the money for the TUERK conference has been paid since the conference will be on-line now and free. Response was no monies has been paid yet.
- 4) **RD Report**: Below are excerpts from the report
- a) The bi-annual zonal meeting was held on July the 26th Tentative date for next one will be on January. Chesapeake Region to host. Not sure if it is going to happen in-person.
- b) Shared event with North East Zone (NEZF) and cooperation. Plans are being made for a multi-regional North Eastern Service Symposium (NESSNA) on May 21, 20121 at Boston Peabody Marriott. Theme will be "A posture of the Heart".
- c) Bank account is being opened for the zone. Each region is asked to put forth a contribution of \$25.00
- d) The AZF will be meeting September 21 virtually.

e) WSC II has begun. RD and RD alternate have attended a couple of sessions.

- b) There is a 86% decline in literature purchase at the World and a 58% decline of orders. World is currently operating on an Emergency budget with an over-all decrease on expenses.

- a) 104 shifts filled out of 107. Open shifts are Monday 5-8 PM, Tuesday 5-8 PM, and Thursday 7:30 AM-1PM
- b) In June there were 115 Incoming calls, 20 missed calls and 1 Voice Mail and a percentage missed of 16.52%.
- In July there were 107 incoming calls, 17 missed calls, and 3 Voice Mails and a percentage missed of 15.6%. Two workers missed their entire shifts: one was sick, the other AWOL.
- Before COVID, the number of monthly calls was around 200
- 9) **Treasurer Report:** Beginning balance: \$5,695.76; Area donation \$5,413.49= \$11,109.25 minus \$5,418.41 Expenses for a balance of \$5,690.84
 - After earmarked and prudent reserve, there is a balance of \$951.99 are available for donation at the World.
 - \$1000 earmarked for the Tuerk Conference will also be released. Still has money earmarked for two future billboards, \$3,800.00.

10) Freestate Convention:

- a) Meet 2nd Wednesday of each month.
- b) Look for Lower Room rates (\$96.00) in hotel
- c) No contract signed yet. The board is looking at the legal aspect with an attorney
- d) The board also aims to increase new people and young people participation at the convention It also thinks \$40.00 registration fees is too high and discriminatory to young people and new comers. A \$20,00 walking registration fee would be more affordable.
- e) In order to achieve these deals, they are looking at better deal with hotel and to reduce futile expenses.
- f) They will also explore to have 200 Newcomers packages.
- g) The board also has filled all positions. Sub-committees are still being organized. Baltimore area is in charge of Registration

- a) Applied and received a \$2000 small business association grant. Do not have to pay back. Business has decreased.
